

CITY OF HARRISBURG ORDINANCE #2018-02,
TO AMEND THE TITLE 7, TRAFFIC CODE,
OF THE REVISED MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Harrisburg as follows:

ARTICLE I – PURPOSE AND JURISDICTION

SECTION 1 – PURPOSE.

Ordinance #2018-02 is an ordinance to amend Title 7 of the Revised Municipal Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg with an addition. The City Council of the City of Harrisburg has deemed these regulations and controls to be reasonable and reasonably related to the purpose of promoting the health, safety, and general welfare of the City of Harrisburg.

SECTION 2 – JURISDICTION.

This Ordinance shall govern all territory within the statutory jurisdiction of the City of Harrisburg, South Dakota.

SECTION 3 – SEVERABILITY AND SEPARABILITY.

Should any Article, Section, Subsection, or Provision of this Ordinance be found to be or declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the portion so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

ARTICLE II – AMENDMENT TO TITLE 7, TRAFFIC CODE

A. Add Chapter 7.0214: Corner cutting, to read:

It shall be unlawful for any person to drive any motor vehicle upon or across any sidewalk, driveway, filling station, or other commercial driveway or similar surface located at the corner of any intersection that is protected by a traffic light or other traffic signal or sign for the purpose of evading the regulations governing the stopping, yielding, or turning of motor vehicles at intersections.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Harrisburg that this Ordinance shall become effective in accordance to law.
