

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-03

A RESOLUTION REVISING SUBDIVISION AUTHORITY BOUNDARY OUTSIDE OF THE MUNICIPAL LIMITS BETWEEN THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS AND THE CITY OF HARRISBURG.

WHEREAS, the City of Harrisburg by Resolution 2016-14 and the City of Sioux Falls by Resolution No. 32-17 have agreed to a subdivision authority boundary line as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the centerlines of 479<sup>th</sup> Ave. and 271<sup>st</sup> St., then west along the centerline of 271<sup>st</sup> St. until the intersection of centerlines of 271<sup>st</sup> St. and Western Ave., then south along the centerline of Western Ave. until the centerlines of Western Ave. and 272<sup>nd</sup> St., then west along the centerline of 272<sup>nd</sup> St. until the endpoint at the intersection of centerlines of 272<sup>nd</sup> St. and the center of the right-of-way for Interstate 29;

WHEREAS, the City of Harrisburg will have the capability to provide sanitary sewer service to areas south of 271<sup>st</sup> St. and east of Interstate 29 as a result of a trunk sewer project planned for construction in the year 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City of Harrisburg has determined that it is necessary to revise the current subdivision authority boundary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Harrisburg City Council that the subdivision authority boundary line between the City of Harrisburg and the City of Sioux Falls shall be amended as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the centerlines of 479<sup>th</sup> Ave. and 271<sup>st</sup> St., then west along the centerline of 271<sup>st</sup> St. until the endpoint at the intersection of centerlines of 271<sup>st</sup> St. and the center of the right-of-way for Interstate 29, as shown on the attached map and made part of this resolution for reference.
