

CITY OF HARRISBURG ORDINANCE #2021-09,
TO AMEND URBAN & RURAL SERVICE DISTRICT REGULATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Harrisburg as follows:

ARTICLE I – PURPOSE AND JURISDICTION

SECTION 1 – PURPOSE.

Ordinance #2021-09 is an ordinance to amend the Urban & Rural Service District Regulations of the City of Harrisburg. The City Council of the City of Harrisburg has deemed these regulations and controls to be reasonable and reasonably related to the purpose of promoting the health, safety, and general welfare of the City of Harrisburg.

SECTION 2 – JURISDICTION.

This Ordinance shall govern all territory within the statutory jurisdiction of the City of Harrisburg, South Dakota.

SECTION 3 – SEVERABILITY AND SEPARABILITY.

Should any Article, Section, Subsection, or Provision of this Ordinance be found to be or declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the portion so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

**ARTICLE II – AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 11.05: URBAN & RURAL
SERVICE DISTRICT REGULATIONS**

A. That Section 11.0507 be added to read:

11.0507 Procedure to amend Exhibit A to include or exclude lands included in the Rural Service District. Exhibit A, as described in Section 11.0503, may be amended by resolution of the City Council to include additional lands into the Rural Service District or to remove lands from the Rural Service District.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Harrisburg that this Ordinance shall become effective in accordance to law.
