

CITY OF HARRISBURG ORDINANCE #2022-07,
TO AMEND PENALTY REGULATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Harrisburg as follows:

ARTICLE I – PURPOSE AND JURISDICTION

SECTION 1 – PURPOSE.

Ordinance #2022-07 is an ordinance to amend the Penalty Regulations of the City of Harrisburg. The City Council of the City of Harrisburg has deemed these regulations and controls to be reasonable and reasonably related to the purpose of promoting the health, safety, and general welfare of the City of Harrisburg.

SECTION 2 – JURISDICTION.

This Ordinance shall govern all territory within the statutory jurisdiction of the City of Harrisburg, South Dakota.

SECTION 3 – SEVERABILITY AND SEPARABILITY.

Should any Article, Section, Subsection, or Provision of this Ordinance be found to be or declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the portion so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

**ARTICLE II – AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 12.01: PENALTIES
REGULATIONS**

A. That new Section 12.0101 be added (and other sections renumbered) to read:

12.0101 Schedule of fines: The amount of a fine for a violation of any section of the City's Codified Ordinances shall be selected from the following schedule:

- A. \$50.00
- B. \$100.00
- C. \$150.00
- D. \$200.00
- E. \$250.00
- F. \$300.00
- G. \$400.00

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Harrisburg that this Ordinance shall become effective in accordance to law.
