General Requirements Informal Construction Contracts (Contracts under \$100,000)


1. The Contractor gives the following assurances:


- a. This bid is inclusive of all permit fees and sales/use and excise tax.
- b. It maintains any licenses required to perform the work.
- c. It operates an independent business and is contracting to do work according to its own methods, without being subject to the control of the City, except as to the product of the result of the work. It and its employees are not employees of the City.
- d. It will hold the City harmless from claims for bodily or property damage arising out of the work performed under this contract.
- 2. **Progress Payments:** Partial payments of not less than \$5,000.00 will be processed for work completed each month.
- 3. Contractor's Liability Insurance: The Contractor shall secure the insurance specified below and shall cause all its consultants/subcontractors to do likewise. All insurance shall be issued by an insurance company(s) acceptable to the City. The insurance specified may be in policy or policies of insurance, primary or excess. Certificates of all required insurance shall be provided to the City upon execution of this agreement. Exceptions to this policy must be approved by the City Attorney's Office and Risk Management.
 - a. Worker's compensation. The policy shall provide the statutory limits required by South Dakota law. In addition, it shall provide Coverage B, Employer's Liability coverage of not less than \$1,000,000 each accident, \$1,000,000 disease policy limits. The required limit may be met by excess liability (umbrella) coverage.
 - b. Commercial general liability. The policy shall provide occurrence form contractual, personal injury, bodily injury, and property damage liability coverage with limits of at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence, \$2,000,000 general aggregate, and \$2,000,000 aggregate products and completed operations. The required limits may include excess liability (umbrella) coverage. The policy shall name the City and its representatives as an additional insured. If "occurrence form" insurance is not available, "claims made" insurance will be acceptable. The policy shall be maintained for three years after completion of this contractor.
 - c. Automobile liability. The policy shall cover all owned, non-owned, and hired automobiles, trucks, and trailers. The coverage shall be as broad as that found in the standard comprehensive automobile liability policy with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit each occurrence. The required limit may include excess liability (umbrella) coverage.
 - d. Notice of Cancellation. The Contractor will provide the City with at least thirty days written notice of an insurer's intent to cancel or not renew any of the insurance coverage. The Contractor agrees to hold the City harmless from any liability, including additional premium due because of the Contractor's failure to maintain the coverage limits required.
 - e. Acceptance of proof of insurance. The City's acceptance of a certificate of insurance does not mean the City assumes responsibility for its validity. Nor does it mean the City represents the coverage and limits required are adequate to protect the Contractor.


Special Requirements Informal – Construction Contracts (Contracts under \$100,000)


The following items shall be considered incidental to the project:


- Protect and Safeguard: Contractor shall protect and safeguard all adjacent properties, streets, sidewalk, and underground utilities during the duration of construction. All damages due to the Contractor's negligence's will be the sole responsibility of the Contractor.
- 2. **Traffic Control:** The Contractor shall provide necessary barricades, signage, and road closures as needed for the protection of the work and safety of the public.
- 3. **Erosion Control:** The Contractor shall provide necessary erosion control for the project.
- 4. **Street Sweeping:** Contractor shall protect and sweep all effected streets at the end of each working day.
- 5. **Notice:** The Contractor shall provide 48-hour notice prior to road closures and water shutdowns. Notices shall be provided to Ross Kuchta at Stockwell Engineers (605) 310-2533.
- Final Inspection: The Contractor shall request a final inspection from the Owner and Engineer.
 Items in need of correction shall be noted on a punch list and be resolved within 14 working days of receipt of the punch list.
- 7. **Final Payment:** Final payment will be made within 30 days of completion of the project and punch list.











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
Location Map
