U.S. Department of Transportation Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant Application

WHEREAS, the U.S Department of Transportation operates the Safe Streets and Roads for All grant program, and

WHEREAS, the Safe Streets and Roads for All grant program allows for a regional Safety Action Plan managed by eligible agencies, and

WHEREAS, the City of Harrisburg desires assistance from the U.S. Department of Transportation Safe Streets and Roads for All Planning and Demonstration grant program for the purpose of developing a Safety Action Plan, and

WHEREAS, the South Eastern Council of Governments is an eligible planning agency that serves Clay, Lincoln, McCook, Minnehaha, Turner, and Union counties in southeastern South Dakota.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Harrisburg City Council hereby commits to the support of the creation of a regional Safety Action Plan managed by the South Eastern Council of Governments, and
- 2. The City of Harrisburg commits to providing \$5,000 in local cash match for the project in addition to 10.5 hours of in-kind or cash match and provide such additional information as may be required.
