

Harrisburg City Council
Special Meeting Minutes

A special meeting of the City Council was called to order on March 21, 2019, at 8:05am. Present was Mayor Julie Burke – Van Luvanee, Council members Ryan Berg, and Kevin Maxwell. Also present from the City were Michael McMahon, Toby Huizenga, Andrew Pietrus, Joe Stonesifer and Jill Johnke. All motions were by majority vote and approved unanimously by those members present unless otherwise indicated.

Business Item 2. Providing staff support and resources to neighboring communities in the event of the Big Sioux Flooding Event. Pietrus mentioned the city is a member of SD Warn which supplies resources to its members. Motion Berg, seconded Maxwell to lend resources as needed to communities.
